Sandy Clancy (CATHERINE)






Brad Walker (ROBERT)




Mike Daniel (HAL)







Lydia Cochran | Co-Artistic Director



Rob Klimeczko | Founder & Executive Director





Our auditions are open to everyone. Whether you're a veteran performer who just moved to town or you've never been on stage before but really want to try, we'd like to encourage you to audition for shows at Studio Theatre Worcester. We're just now entering our 5th year, and we couldn't have lasted so long without new people, new talent, and new voices.

We cast both non-equity and AEA performers. When we cast AEA actors, we utilize Special Appearance and Guest Artist contracts. All of our non-equity performers are compensated in the form of a modest stipend.

We hold auditions on a show-by-show basis. Auditions are announced in many places. In addition to our website, we announce auditions on our social media channels, so make sure you follow us. Auditions are also posted on BroadwayWorld, NETheatre 411, and METRMag. We also attend the Boston Area Theatre Auditions (BATA) each Spring.




